Repurpose

If you are considering purchasing new furniture due to a move or renovation, we encourage you to first explore opportunities to repurpose existing furniture within your organization or donate Nucraft products to a local charity or non-profit. Keeping furniture in use helps conserve resources, reduce waste, and lower the environmental impacts associated with replacement and transportation. You may consider the following organizations to identify an appropriate next-life solution for your company:

- [Green Standards](#) is a global leader in sustainable office decommissioning that helps organizations donate their surplus furniture. It provides free office furniture—with free delivery—to registered non-profits and community organizations on behalf of their corporate clients and partners. Green Standards serve large companies.
- [Habitat ReStores](#) are independently owned reuse stores operated by local Habitat for Humanity organizations. They accept donations and sell to the public, diverting reusable product from area landfills. The proceeds are used to build, rehabilitate and repair safe and affordable homes in the community.
- [ANEW](#) works with corporate companies to steward their surplus office furniture away from landfill and back into their communities by matching these items to local organizations.
- Grassroots local organizations in your community may be available to provide similar services.

Recycle
